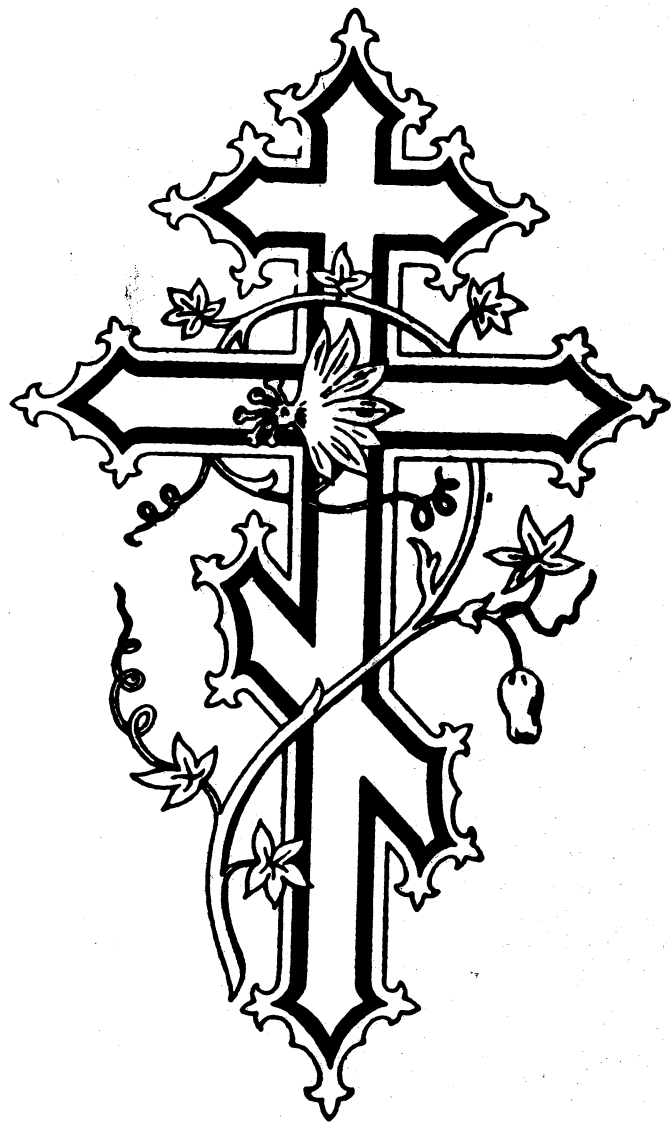


**Calendar
of the
Orthodox Church**



The Ecclesiastical Year of the Eastern Orthodox usually is considered to begin with the Sunday of the Pharisee & Publican (ten sundays before Easter). The various Feasts of the Church fall into three types, with their sub-divisions: a. Great Feasts (Easter, Christmas, Epiphany, Hypapante, Annunciation, Palm Sunday, Ascension, Pentecost, Transfiguration, Repose of Theotokos, Nativity of Theotokos, Exaltation of Holy Cross, Presentation of Theotokos) plus those of secondary status (Circumcision, Nativity of John Baptist, SS Peter & Paul, Beheading of John Baptist) b. Middle Feasts (two types) - i. Commemorative days that have the addition of a Canon, at Matins, honoring the Theotokos ii. Commemorative days that have the 'polyeleos' (135 & 136 Psalm, so-called from the continued repetition of the mercy of God) in the Matins c. Little Feasts (two types) - i. Those which have the Great Doxology at Matins ii. Those which do not have the Great Doxology at Matins.

SEQUENCE OF GOSPEL LESSONS -

Each day of the year has its proper Gospel lesson, and, with the exception of Feast Days, they follow one another in order and sequence from the beginning of an Evangelist to the end.

St. John - This Gospel is read for seven weeks in all, beginning from Easter Sunday until Pentecost Sunday, inclusive, except for three days.

St. Matthew - This Gospel is read from the Monday After Pentecost until the Friday After the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (Sept. 14th). During the first eleven weeks it is read every day; from the twelfth week, it is read only on Saturdays and Sundays. St. Mark's Gospel is read on the remaining weekdays.

St. Luke - This Gospel is read from the Monday After the Exaltation of the Holy Cross until the Sunday of the Prodigal Son, for a total of twelve weeks. From the thirteenth week it is read only on Saturdays and Sundays. St. Mark's Gospel is read on the remaining weekdays.

St. Mark - This Gospel is read on certain days, as noted above; the balance of it is read on the five Saturdays and Sundays during the Great Fast (Lent).

FIXED DAYS OF THE CHURCH YEAR

EASTERN ORTHODOX CATHOLIC CHURCH IN AMERICA

The Church Year commences on September 1st; it consists of both Movable and Fixed Days. The Movable Days are dependent upon the annual date for Easter. In the following list, the Major Feast Days, with fixed dates, are all capitalized.

NOTE: Sunday Lessons for days before and after Epiphany directly relate to the date of Easter for each year. The following directions clarify what lesson is used, accordingly.

If Easter occurs on:

April 4th, 5th, 6th - There is no Sunday After Epiphany, and the Sunday of the Publican and Pharisee follows, instead. However, the Sunday lessons of the Sunday After Epiphany are, in that case, used on Monday, Jan 7th morning.

April 7th thru 13th - The Sunday After Epiphany is used.

April 14th thru 21st - The Sunday After Epiphany is used, plus an additional Sunday, which is the 15th of S. Luke, known as the Sunday of Zaccaeus.

April 21st thru 27th - The Sunday After Epiphany is used, plus two additional Sundays, which are, in sequence: 12th Sunday of S. Luke, known as the Sunday of the 'Ten Lepers'; and then the 15th Sunday of S. Luke, mentioned above.

April 28th thru May 4th - The Sunday After Epiphany is used, plus three additional Sundays, which are, in sequence: 12th of S. Luke, 15th of S. Luke, and 17th of S. Luke, this latter is also known as 'Sunday of Canaanite Woman'.

May 5th thru 8th - The Sunday After Epiphany is used, plus four additional Sundays, which are, in sequence: 12th of S. Luke, 14th of S. Luke, 15th of S. Luke, 17th of S. Luke - BUT, if the 14th of S. Luke has already been used, heretofore during the year, the 2nd lesson in this group becomes the 15th of S. Luke, and the 3rd lesson becomes the 16th of S. Matthew.

The PSALTER

The Psalms are divided into twenty sections (cathismata), as follows:

1. Ps. 1-8 (inclusive)	11. Ps. 78-85
2. 9-17	12. — 86-91
3. 18-24	13. 92-101
4. 25-32	14. 102-105
5. 33-37	15. 106-109

Each of these sections is divided into three stanzas; and at the end of the latter, not of each Psalm, as in the Western Church, the 'Glory' is chanted. (*Laodicea Canon #17: 'The Psalms are not to be joined together in the congregations, but a lesson shall intervene after every Psalm'). Note: The term 'cathisma', used here, is not to be confounded with the term so employed when speaking of a type of the troparion (Cathismata).

The use of the Psalms, in liturgical practice, varies according to the time of the year and of the Feast. For example: in the 9th & 10th weeks before Easter, two cathismata are used at Matins and one at Vespers; in the six weeks of the Great Fast, the quantity is doubled; from Great Thursday to Sunday of St. Thomas it is not used at all; at Vespers of Sunday of St. Thomas, till the 20th of September, two cathismata are chanted at Matins and one at Vespers; from then till the Fast of the Nativity, three cathismata are used in Matins, with one, the 18th, at Vespers, together with the 133rd & 136th Psalms; from Nativity till Epiphany, two are used at Matins and one at Vespers.

Certain technical names have also been given to some Psalms: the 119th is always called 'Amomos', from the opening words 'Blessed are those that are blameless'. The 135th & 136th Psalms, said together, are the 'Polyeleos', from the continued repetition in the latter of the words 'mercy of God'. The 104th is the 'Proemiac', because it commences the Vespers. The 'Proskyria' are the Psalms of degrees, so called from the opening words 'Unto the Lord in my trouble, I called'. The 'Hexapsalmos' denotes the six Psalms of Matins (3rd, 38th, 63rd, 88th, 103rd, 143rd). The 'Tripsalmos' does not denote any particular set of Psalms, but varies its meaning according to the hours at which it may said. The 'Praises' are the usual name for the 148th, 149th, 150th Psalms.
